AMY TRICHON NACKE was interviewed at her residence, [redacted] New Hope, Pennsylvania PA 18938 regarding background information on her husband, LOUIS J. NACKE, II, who was killed when United Airlines UA Flight 93 crashed in Somerset County, PA, on September 11, 2001, en route to San Francisco, California CA. Present during the interview of NACKE were her mother, SALLY N. WEISBERG and step-father, ROBERT A. WEISBERG. NACKE was provided with the identities of the interviewing agents.
